

# Dear readers,


The return of the MICHELIN Guide could be seen as a birthday present for the Austria Tourism: the organisation is celebrating its  $70^{th}$  anniversary this year.

# Holidays in Austria 2025

Forget everyday life, unwind amidst nature and feel what really matters. This can be done as early as spring, while cycling along a river or hiking on tranquil high-altitude trails. Families find their holiday bliss between bathing lakes and alpine pastures. And city trips promise to spoil the senses all year round. The Austrian "Lebensgefühl" has so many facets.

#### Desire to move. Hiking, biking, canyoning & co.

Cycling and hiking enthusiasts rejoice just beyond the Bavarian border. **The Danube Upper Austria region** delights with its unique river landscape. The Donausteig long-distance hiking trail and legendary Danube Cycle Path lead through the UNESCO World Heritage region. Bikers will find a wealth of MTB and gravel bike routes in the **Tiroler Zugspitz Arena**. The new escape trails through the impressive mountains are as tricky as they are entertaining. Another tip for thrill seekers is the nearby **Imst Outdoor Region** with Austria's largest outdoor adventure park, AREA 47. Look forward to rafting, climbing and more.

Mountain lovers have always been drawn to the **Tirolean Zillertal**, but trend sports such as canyoning and countless culinary huts also impress in the "Valley of the Three-Thousand-Metre Peaks". Paths steeped in history await you in the **TirolWest Holiday Region**, such as the Castle Trail or the Stanzer Zwetschke route with its distilleries. The **Bregenzerwald** in Vorarlberg is also a great place to "actively enjoy" with its Culinary Hikes and cycle paths. Here you will also discover old and new wooden architecture on tours of the local villages. In the **Montafon**, on the other hand, a number of hiking routes lead into a fascinating realm of water, from the Aquaweg in the valley to the glacier stream in the high mountains.

#### Time together. Memorable moments with loved ones

The Tirolean Mountains conceal your new favourite spots at all altitudes. At Lake **Achensee**, families can look forward to hikes through Karwendel Nature Park and adventures on the water or via ferrata. There's no chance of boredom in the **Alpbachtal** either, with its fun-filled mountains and refreshing bathing lakes. The region's three gorges are a must for nature lovers. A family holiday that is just as heart-warming and close to nature awaits you in the **Wildschönau**. There's extra fun to be had here at Drachental Family Park. And on the high plateau of **Serfaus-Fiss-Ladis**, adventure mountains and bike trails promise action, fun and discovery.

In the **Murau region of Styria**, pine forests and lofty heights become a discovery zone, while sun-drenched and lake-rich **Carinthia** scores with swimming and cycling as early as May. Leisurely mountain biking and exciting themed trails delight families in SalzburgerLand, and in **Altenmarkt-Zauchensee** the Erlebnistherme Amadé also entices you to dive right in. In **St. Johann** the "Salzburg Summit Game" leads to ancient places of power. The varied holiday programmes across Austria's regions guarantee good moods all round – for kids and teens, parents and grandparents.

#### On a journey of discovery. Enjoy city and countryside


The beauty of Austria: cities and countryside lie side by side. This is also the case in the UNESCO World Heritage City of Salzburg with its baroque gardens, squares and churches. Music and theatre festivals as well as the Salzburg Festival draw visitors here year after year. Those looking for some downtime will find it on the green local mountains of the City of Mozart. In Austria's Small Historic Towns, historical flair intertwines with enchanting landscapes, such as in Radstadt in SalzburgerLand or in the Hall-Wattens region with the medieval Hall in Tirol. Cultural enjoyment meets southern lightness in Klagenfurt am Wörthersee, which surprises with festivals ranging from literature to Alps-Adriatic cuisine and great bike tours. The love of life is also at home in Southern Burgenland, where three wine routes invite you to hike, e-bike and enjoy.

#### To Austria by train. Convenient, affordable, climate-friendly

With more than 50 direct train connections by day or night, travellers can get to Austria quickly and in a climate-friendly way. Tickets are available from 37.99 euros, and from 19.99 euros for short distances (e.g. Munich-Tirol). Children up to 15 years even travel free of charge with an accompanying person (from 15 years of age). Bookings for journeys from Switzerland can be made via SBB or ÖBB. Shuttles, public and regional transport can be used to get around locally and are usually included in the guest cards. # Bad Tatzmannsdorf is a certified hiking village

At the beginning of 2025, Bad Tatzmannsdorf, the starting point of many delightful hikes, became Southern Burgenland's first certified hiking village. To celebrate this award, the village is inviting guests on a hike along the Friedensweg on 29th March 2025. The trail connects Bad Tatzmannsdorf with its neighbouring villages. Six of Bad Tatzmannsdorf's hotels and inns can also call themselves certified hiking hosts.

### Carinthia

#### Path of the Planets

The so-called "Weg der Planeten" (Path of the Planets), which is barrier-free in sections, will open in summer 2025 on the Gerlitzen, where a solar observatory is located. Along the 2.5 km trail, visitors will learn more about the solar system and natural history. The newly designed path replaces the previous Kanzelhöhe circuit. Part of it is designed to also accommodate those with limited mobility.

# **Upper Austria**

#### Bad Kreuzen: Upper Austria's first hiking village

In the Strudengau region lies Bad Kreuzen, Upper Austria's first certified hiking village. Hiking trails run through the impressive river landscape along the Danube, across green hills and through refreshing gorges and ravines such as the Wolfsschlucht and Stillensteinklamm. Bad Kreuzen is located on the 450 km long Donausteig long-distance hiking trail. The approximately 10 km long Herzklopfen circuit, which starts at Kreuzen Castle and has plenty of viewpoints, is also a lovely walk. Four certified hiking establishments and experienced guides ensure that hiking enthusiasts are well looked after.

# **Upper Austria**

#### Uniform signage in the Innviertel

The Innviertel has optimised its network of hiking trails on an Austria-wide unique scale. Since autumn 2024, new, uniform signage has been providing a better overview across 30 municipalities, 131 connected routes and 1,000 km of trails. QR codes on each signpost and the GPS localisation of all trails provide hikers with modern tools to find their way and link excursion tips, sights, events and restaurants. In addition, the main map (print) gives a good overview of all hiking trails. Large overview boards in the 30 local centres complete the range of information offered.

#### "Path of Mindfulness" in Grüngu im Almtal

The 96 km long "Path of Mindfulness" will open in the Almtal in spring 2025. The spiritual hiking trail leads from the "House of Mindfulness" in Grünau im Almtal via the Brunnental, Steyrtal and Kremstal back to the Almtal in five daily stages. Stations provide impulses for meditation along the way. Accompanying brochures provide further information on the trail. Guided mindfulness tours complete the offer.

# SalzburgerLand

#### Schwaighofener Bankerl circuit

Since the summer of 2024, hikers have been able to learn interesting facts about the local area on the Schwaighofener Bankerl circuit. From the centre of Eugendorf, the 13 km long trail leads through gently rolling countryside. Display boards and stories that can be accessed via QR codes convey more about local history, culture, particularities and agriculture. Numerous benches invite you to have a seat, listen and look around along the way.

#### Agriculture-themed trail

Since October 2024, a family-friendly theme trail has been revealing interesting facts about living and working on a farm in Uttendorf, Schwarzenbach district. Twelve child-friendly boards provide insights into the processes on a farm along the almost 4 km long route. Families will also find benches to take breaks.

#### Kringsalmbahn chairlift in Obertauern

In addition to the Grünwaldkopfbahn and the Hochalmbahn, the Kringsalmbahn will also be in operation in Obertauern from summer 2025. The 6-seater chairlift takes hikers from 1,800 to 2,025 m above sea level in just under four minutes and to the starting point of picturesque hikes.

#### Kolm Saigurn circuit

The popular Kolm Saigurn circuit in the Rauris Valley has been shining in new glory since summer 2024. Mudslides in the previous year made it necessary to rebuild the path. The almost 3 km long, family-friendly circuit takes about one and a half hours to complete on foot. Highlights along the way include five waterfalls and a suspension bridge, which leads over a roaring torrent to the Naturfreundehaus.

#### Adler Toni adventure trail

There will be a new attraction for families and nature lovers in Neukirchen am Großvenediger from June 2025 in the shape of the "Adler Toni" theme trail. The approximately 1 km long path runs from the end of the popular slide trail at Gasthof Stockenbaum to the centre of Neukirchen. En route, eight child-friendly activity stations invite you to take an imaginative journey through the local flora and fauna. The attractions include a suspension bridge, balancing course, marmot burrow and cool water station.

#### Vegan high-altitude circuit in the Gesäuse

The Gesäuse Hut Tour leads around 90 km through one of the last authentic natural landscapes in the Alpine region in seven stages (which can also be hiked individually). From summer 2025, six huts have a new treat in store: each will offer at least one vegan dish. The idea behind it: Hiking and connecting with nature go hand in hand – so why not on your plate too? This is how Europe's first vegan mountain trail was born, which invites hikers to enjoy plant-based versions of traditional hut dishes for seven days.

# Mountain experiences with the Loser panorama lift

The Loser Panoramabahn launched into operation in autumn 2024 with its valley station in Altaussee. Thanks to the new cable car, it will be possible for hiking enthusiasts to travel comfortably from Altaussee to the 1,600 m high Loseralm from summer 2025. From the Loser Plateau, numerous hiking trails and mountain tours lead to peaks and lovely lookout points. The cable car is barrier-free. Its cabins can also be used to transport buggies and mountain bikes.

Bad Waltersdorf celebrated the launch of its new "Genusstour" (pleasure tour) in October 2024. The 12 km route leads around the town under the motto "stop and taste". There are 19 adventure stations and 13 culinary stations along the way. The adventure stations encourage you to stop and take a look, solve a puzzle or have a play. Sweets, savoury snacks and refreshments are offered at the culinary stations, which include cafés, inns and wine taverns.

#### Leutasch hut hike for families

# "Wildschönau Whirlwind" family hiking trail


Games, adventure and lots of fun – the new "Wildschönau Whirlwind" trail between Niederau and Oberau will be granting all three wishes from summer 2025. Across 4 km, several stations encourage kids to play, embark on adventures and make discoveries in the midst of nature. There are also rest and lookout points by a small stream and in particularly idyllic places to take breaks along the way. The proximity to the edge of the forest provides refreshing shade in summer. Without any major climbs, young hikers stay motivated for a long time, meaning adults can relax and enjoy the view of the high valley and Tirolean mountains.

#### Digital hiking trails in the Silberregion Karwendel

Accompanied by the Locandy app, adventurers will be able to explore the Silberregion Karwendel along three new digital hiking trails from summer 2025. On the 3 km long "Way of the Senses" in Hochpillberg, works of art encourage you to stop and reflect. The 2.5 km long "Planet Trail" in Terfens depicts the planets of our solar system, whilst the 2.6 km long "Miners' Trail" near Schwaz provides insights into the mining history of the region, leading (amongst other things) to an original tunnel from the  $16^{\rm th}$  century.

# Vorarlberg

#### Improvements along the Green Ring

Lech am Arlberg is pushing summer tourism and, among other things, making the Green Ring even more attractive. The 28.5 km long hiking trail leads around Lech Zürs, following the legendary White Ring ski circuit. From summer 2025, the loveliest spots along the trail will be easier to reach. In addition to the Rüfikopf, Seekopf, Oberlech and Petersboden lifts, the new Zugerbergbahn will also take hikers up and down. But that's not all. Well-known architectural firm Snøhetta is designing the roof of the Zugerbergbahn, so that the mountain landscape is reflected in the water surface of the flooded roof, depending on light and weather. The Balmalp will have a lounge for children and families as well as a circular trail, whilst a barefoot path is being created on the Rud-Alpe and the water playground is being updated.

# New culinary hiking tour in the Bregenzerwald

For those who like to combine walking with pleasure, the Bregenzerwald offers six "Culinary Hikes". The hikes can be booked as day packages, leading step by step from one course to the next. Guests get to enjoy their breakfast, lunch and dessert at various mountain inns and restaurants. A new addition from summer 2025 is the hike from Bezau up the Niedere and back down to the valley – with mountain breakfast, lunch on an alpine pasture and dessert in Bezau. The pure walking time is around four hours. The hike can be booked between 30th May and 31st August 2025.

#### New variants along the Arlberg Trail

The approximately 50 km long Arlberg Trail connects the five Arlberg resorts of Lech, Zürs, Stuben, St. Anton and St. Christoph amidst spectacular alpine scenery. In addition to the relatively demanding original route, there will be less strenuous trail variants from summer 2025. They will cater for those who would prefer to take it easy, making more frequent use of cable cars and leading along less steep sections.



#### Playful hiking in Oberlech

From June 2025, a new theme trail between Oberlech and Petersboden will invite children to embark on playful nature adventures. Along the almost 3 km long, leisurely path, eight nature games make the "Gipslöcher" nature reserve come alive. The games involve what lies along the way, prompted by signboards. Around a thousand craters (so-called dolines) form this geologically unique area. They are a treasure trove for botanists, with around 20 different types of orchids growing here.

# Two new routes in the MTB ZONE Bikepark Petzen

For 40 years, MTB ZONE manager Diddie Schneider has been planning and creating the best bike trails around the globe. Over 10 years ago he opened Europe's longest flow country trail at the time on the Petzen, which the International Mountain Bicycling Association recognised as the world's best of its kind. Since then, the park has welcomed bike enthusiasts with trails of all difficulty levels – and in 2025 two new ones leading through the forest will be added to the offer. One is a 1.5 km trail with several jumps, wooden elements, and drops (moderate to difficult), while the other one, 1.4 km long and with several jumps, rocky steps, and gaps, is more natural and requires good technique from bikers (moderate).

# **Upper Austria**

#### **Discovery Bike Tour**

In the west of Upper Austria, between the Salzach, Inn and Mattigtal, lies the "Entdeckerviertel" region of discovery. Those who would like to explore the gently rolling landscape by bike will be able to head out on the new Discovery Bike Tour from May 2025. The 180 km route leads around the region and can be easily completed in three to four days. Small historic towns lie along the crossborder route, including the Gothic trading town of Braunau and Burghausen in Bavaria, known for its impressive castle. There are also numerous natural landmarks to discover, such as Ibmer Moor and Weidmoos bird paradise.

#### Bike Trail Area Obertraun

There has been a new trail area at the foot of the Krippenstein since autumn 2024, located above the Austrian Sports Resorts BSFZ Obertraun. On the freely accessible area in the forest, mountain bikers can ride five single trails of different difficulty levels. The routes, which were carefully inserted into the surrounding environment, are 1.5 km long in total. They are also integrated into the 11.5 km long "S218 Koppenwinkel Runde" mountain bike route with a difficulty level of "easy" and serve as attractive connections to the Dachstein-Krippenstein cable car.

#### New lines and trails at Epic Bikepark Leogang

With over 105 km of lines and trails, Leogang is Austria's largest bike region. The centre of the action is Epic Bikepark Leogang, where there is always something new. From summer 2025 there will be a new 1.3 km long red line between Valis Hölle and Bongo Bongo for freeriders. A new 600 m long blue line connects the middle station of the Steinbergbahn with the Steinberg Line by FOX. And on the popular Hangman I, three additional trail variants in black and red promise even more variety.

#### Königslehen Round Tour Radstadt

Radstadt has created a new route for mountain bikers. The moderately difficult, approximately 20 km long Königslehen Round Tour leads from Radstadt in a large arc to the 1,544 m high Kemahdhöhe and back. The beautifully situated Berggasthof Bliembauer is a great place to stop for a bite to eat when you have reached the last third of the route.

#### Kreischi Bikeland

At the foot of the Kreisberg near Murau, the newly created "Kreischi Bikeland" opened in summer 2024. Here, mountain bikers, beginners and children in particular can improve their skills on practice elements of varying difficulty levels. A bike rental and bike school are located nearby.

#### First barrier-free mountain bike trail

At the end of October 2024, the first barrier-free mountain bike trail in Austria and probably even Europe opened in Kobenz in the Mur Valley. The approximately 2 km long flow trail is designed in such a way that it can also be ridden by people with limited mobility using adaptive bikes. Not far from the trail the municipality is also building a barrier-free exercise park, which is to be completed in the course of 2025.

#### **Bikeland Heroes**

Spring 2025 will see the launch of the Bikeland Heroes treasure hunt at the Haus-Aich singletrack in the Schladming-Dachstein region. Solve all of the quizzes on three different loops together with Madame Flow, Jumper and Dr. Drop to receive the Bikeland Hero Award and a small gift. The trails are between 1 and 3 km long and can be ridden by all ages. Admission is free for children under the age of six.

The extended Stadium Flowline will open at Bikepark Schladming at the end of May 2025. Riders will be able to follow the almost 7 km long route all the way from the mountain to the valley, ending at the well-known stadium where the ski races on the Planai also end. Downhillers overcome 1,000 m of altitude on the Stadium Flowline. It has the difficulty level blue (= easy) and is suitable for experienced riders as well as beginners.

What's more, the revised "Bartigs Bödele" trail with optimised flow provides even more riding fun.

# New mountain bike tours in Paznaun-Ischgl

A new 30 km mountain bike tour will connect Ischgl with Ramosch (Scuol) in Switzerland from summer 2025. In addition, the new Fimbapass Marathon (an 80 km round trip) leads from Ischgl across the Fimbapass to Ramosch, via Martina to Samnaun and from there back to Ischgl by cable car. Galtür has also expanded its routes, with a new 1 km long circuit around Faulbrunn Alm that is suitable for beginners and advanced riders alike. Three variations offer technically challenging experiences for advanced bikers. From summer 2025, the Silvretta Bike Arena Ischgl/Samnaun and Silva Trails Galtür will be part of the Gravity Card network. It provides access to 30 top mountain bike destinations in seven European countries.



#### Cool Down Places in Carinthia

Together with local residents, Carinthia's KLAR! Regions (Climate Change Adaptation Model Regions) have selected so-called Cool Down Places. These are freely accessible, shady spots located amidst nature where people can relax and cool down on hot summer days. At the same time, these places provide information about the 17 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Cool Down Places in the Millstätter See – Bad Kleinkirchheim – Nockberge region include the natural wonder of the "Tiebelquellen" springs, the "Schluchtweg" gorge path near Millstatt, St. Lorenz moor and small lakes such as the Urbansee.







#### Reopening of the Liszt House

May 2025 will see the opening of the newly designed museum at the Liszt House in Raiding, the birthplace of Franz Liszt. The exhibition with interactive elements invites visitors to experience Franz Liszt (1811–1886) as a virtuoso, composer and person with all the senses. In line with the quote "Le concert c'est moi" (I am the concert), it shines a light on Liszt's life from different angles and also provides insights into his time in Bayreuth, Weimar and Budapest.

#### artlodge Verditz

Since 2024, Düsseldorf-based Katrin Liesenfeld-Jordan and Dirk Liesenfeld have been transforming artlodge Verditz from a four-star hotel into a space for art. In the beautifully situated property in the middle of Carinthia's Nockberge mountains, the coexistence of art and nature comes to the fore. Artists from Austria and Germany showcase their work in the former hotel rooms and corridors. From  $22^{\text{nd}}\,\text{June}$  to  $7^{\text{th}}$ September 2025, the summer exhibition will focus on pieces by Carinthian artist Terese Kasalicky. The Kunstalm is also worth a visit. 

#### 70 years of Austria Tourism

1955 was a key year in Austrian history: the State Treaty was signed and the "Österreichische Fremdenverkehrswerbung" (Austrian Tourism Advertising) association was founded. The aim was to use tourism to get the country back on its feet economically. Today – 70 years later – tourism is one of Austria's most important economic sectors, recording 154.3 million overnight stays and contributing 6.2% to the gross domestic product. From the 1990s, the association was called "Österreich Werbung" (Austrian National Tourist Office), and in 2001 its structure was changed, since when Austria's nine provinces have participated financially as marketing partners. It has been an exciting journey and the Austria Tourism has accompanied tourism through all phases of development: from the automobile boom in the 60s to package holidays in the 70s and adventure travel in the 80s and 90s. Today the focus is on quality, sustainability and individuality instead of quantity. The core tasks of the Austria Tourism as a national tourism organisation include development of the "Holidays in Austria" brand, opening up the internationally most promising markets and acting as a platform within the Austrian tourism network. Through creative campaigns, around 200 employees from 19 international offices convey the Austrian "Lebensgefühl" to 30 markets around the world.






#### Design history: Radisson Blue Das Triest Vienna

It takes around ten hours for the expert to make a simple dirndl, but elaborate festive dirndls take much longer. The effort is more than worth it for Monika and her customers, as dirndls made of high-quality fabrics never go out of fashion and keep forever.

In 2012, Regina Metzer-Mattes fulfilled her childhood dream: her own garden centre. At the age of just 23, the young woman started her own business in a male-dominated industry and opened reGREENa. Before that she had graduated from the horticultural college in Langenlois and worked in garden centres in Vorarlberg. Today Regina and her team of around ten run a floristry department, a garden centre and a tree nursery in Andelsbuch in the Bregenzerwald. The owner and her husband particularly enjoy growing vegetables, cultivating a 4,500 m² field with great passion. The regionally produced vegetables are extremely popular and almost always sold out.

After working together at several other establishments including the Fuxbau in Stuben am Arlberg, their path led them back to the Klostertal, where Tobias grew up.
