DAY 1

The slopes in St. Anton am Arlberg are not just for experts, everyone will find their own challenge here. Want to get a taste of the high altitude? Then the observation deck on the 2,811m high Valluga is exactly the place you need to visit. The perfect selfie spot is included. You will also be rewarded with a magnificent Alpine panorama as far as the eye can see.
