Hotels in Salzburg and the Salzkammergut Lake Region

Hotels in Tirol

Not far from Aqua Dome is **Das Central – Alpine. Luxury. Life.** in Sölden. The name says it all. It's the perfect hideaway for exacting alpinists with a hint of exclusivity. And for James Bond Fans 007 ELEMENTS, on top of Gaislachkogel - only a cable car ride from Das Central- is the world's first cinematic installation dedicated to the world of James Bond. Next door at restaurant Ice Q James Bond enjoyed his Martini shaken not stirred before he chased villains across the snow in 'Spectre'.

The highest standard of alpine luxury can be found at the **arlberg1800resort** with its heart the Arlberg Hospiz Hotel. Originally built in 1386 as a mountain refuge in St. Christoph at the Arlberg the hotel has been owned by three generations of the Werner family who have grown the resort to a new cultural centre with a concert hall, artist's studio, music studio, exhibition hall and 17 luxurious chalet suites under one roof.
